Solar panels to further improve sustainability





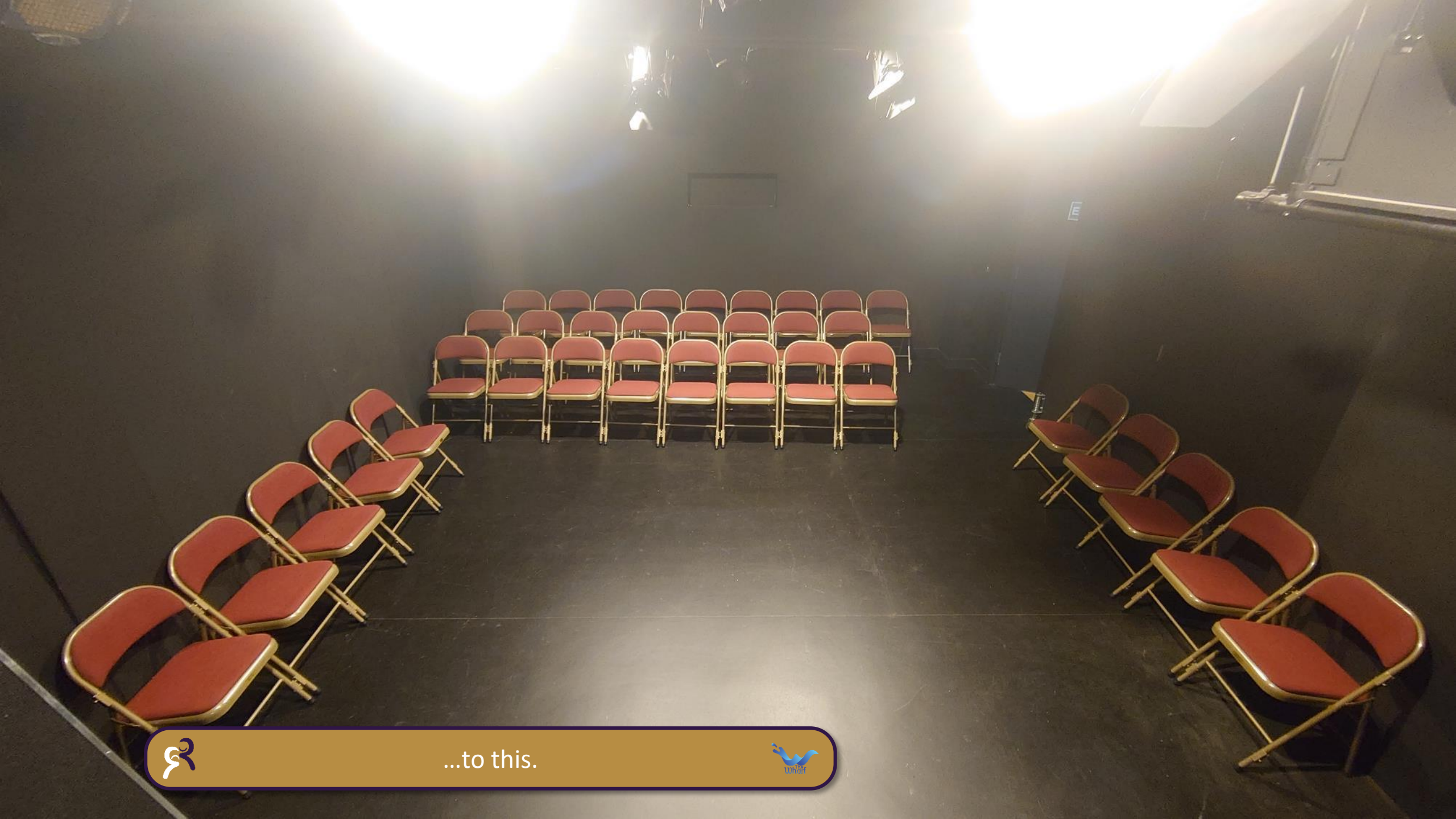

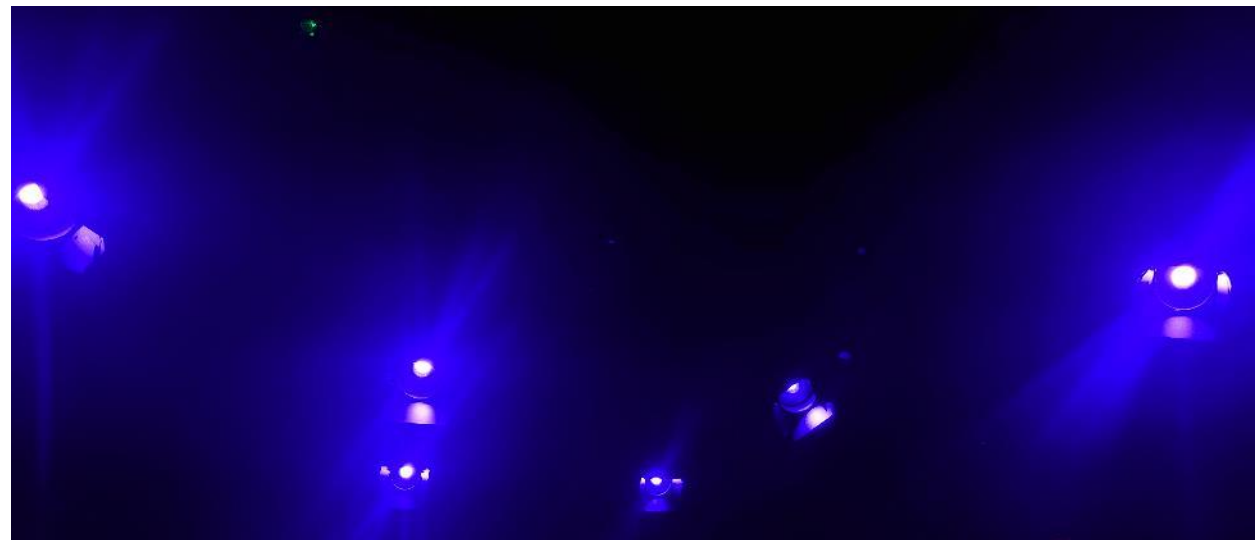
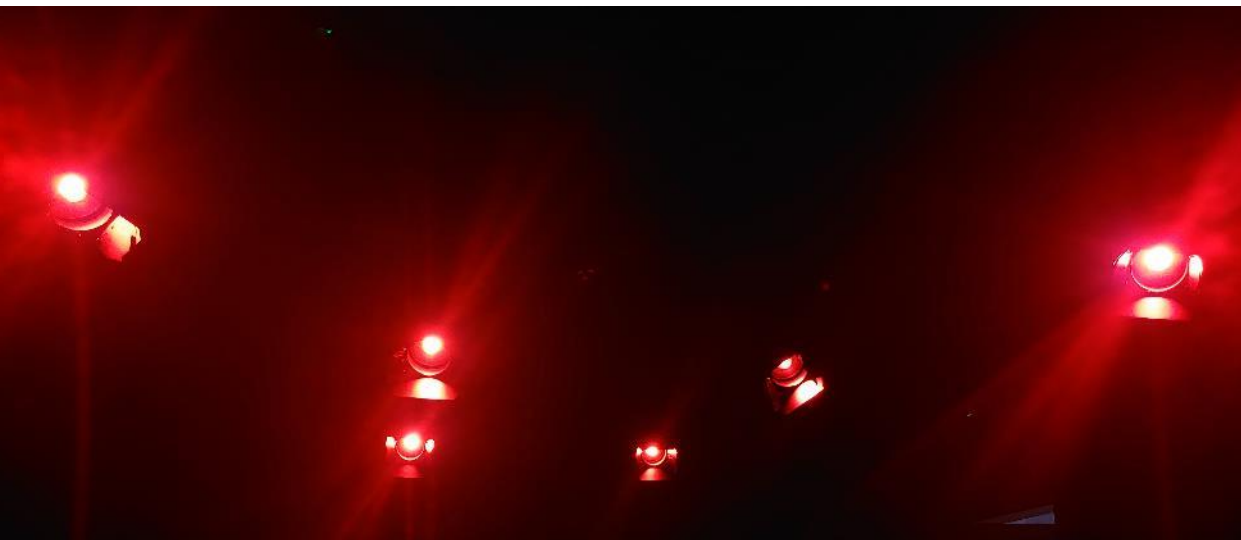
